- --- **Celina, Ohio** An enginehouse for R.J. Corman Western Ohio Lines was severely damaged and a warehouse was also damaged March 14 when a tornado struck in Celina, Ohio. (Trains NewsWire)
- --- Cincinnati, Ohio The city of Cincinnati's sale of the Cincinnati Southern Railway to Norfolk Southern has been completed. Paul Muething, president of the Cincinnati Southern board of trustees, said in a statement available on the railway's website that the board received the \$1.6 billion payment from NS, plus \$20 million in deferred transaction fees, on Friday. The money will be invested through a contract with UBS Financial Services and is projected to generate about \$55 million annually more than twice the approximately \$25 million the city had received under its prior lease. By law, those funds can only be used to rehabilitate, modernize, or replace existing city infrastructure. (Trains NewsWire)
- --- Irvine, Kentucky The John H. Emery Rail Heritage Trust announced on March 5, 2024, that it has awarded \$23,000 to the Kentucky Steam Heritage Corp towards the restoration of Chesapeake and Ohio steam locomotive 2716. The award is targeted for the installation of oil burning equipment in the 80-year-old locomotive which will allow it to burn fuel oil rather than coal. The 2716, a former C&O 2-8-4, is owned by the Kentucky Railway Museum and is on long-term lease to the Kentucky Steam Heritage Corp. (www.kentuckysteam.org)
- --- Peninsula, Ohio, March 4 Cuyahoga Valley Scenic Railroad announced a program called Strategic Enhancements to Aafety and Service Operations. In an effort to further enhance its outstanding safety and service record, CVSR will make substantial investments in key operational areas. These improvements include advancements in radio communications, operations management software, and onboard camera systems. The railroad will also implement new operating rules and procedures tailored to the unique scale of its operations, ensuring a safer and more efficient travel experience for passengers.

To dedicate focused attention to these elaborate and complex initiatives, CVSR will temporarily suspend passenger trains during the next two months. Individuals who have purchased tickets for rides or onboard events from March 8, 2024, through May 2, 2024, will be notified of the cancellations and offered a full refund for their purchase. - --- **Nelsonville, Ohio** The Hocking Valley Scenic Railway has added another engine to their roster. It is EMD SW1200 #1231. They bought this engine from ADM in Columbus, Ohio. It was originally owned by the Norfolk & Portsmouth Belt Line. HVSR says they plan to return the engine to service and use it to pull their passenger trains. (HVSR Facebook page)
- --- On 3/22/24 The Railway Excursion Management Company (Railexco) completed the purchase of property in Madison, Indiana adjacent to the Madison Railroad. This new property will become home to a passenger railcar shop, company office, and on-site storage facility. Founded in 2018, Railexco is now a growing company with a focus on leasing, maintaining, and operating passenger rail equipment. When completed, this investment in Madison is expected to support several full-time and part-time employees. (facebook.com/Railexco)


The Dayton Toledo & Chicago Railway Co.

- 1872 Toledo, Delphos & Indianapolis Railway Inc., March 14, Built, Mercer Delphos
- 1877 Delphos Southern Railway Inc., July 7, 1877, completed track to West Milton, Sept. 1879
- 1879 Incorporated as Dayton, Covington & Toledo, 3 ft. gauge.
- Completed to Covington
 Completed to Versailles as D.C.&T Railroad
 T.D.& I Railway and D.C.&T Railroad purchased by Toledo, Delphos & Burlington and built line between Mercer & Versailles.
- 1882 T.D.B. consolidated by T.C. & St. L Railroad, March 2, 1882
- 1885 T.C.& St. L. Railroad sold at foreclosure to Dayton & Toledo Railroad, Inc. Feb. 7, 1885
- D&T sold 1886 to D&N, Inc. April 23, 1886
 D&N was consolidated with Decatur & Ohio Railway, June 1886 was to build from Willshire, Ohio to Ft. Wayne, not built. Name changed to Dayton & Chicago Railway.
- 1887 D&C and Dayton & Ironton consolidated June 1887 as Dayton, Ft. Wayne & Chicago Railway.
- 1891 D. ft. W. & C Railway sold at foreclosure 1891 to C.D&C, Inc. May 18, 1891
- 1895 C.H.&D Railroad merged with C.D.&.C., C.D.& I. to form C.H.&.D Railway. Changed to Standard gauge.
- 1917 C.H.&.D. was sold to the Toledo & Cincinnati Railroad the Delphos Line was sold to Dayton, Toledo & Chicago Railway, Inc., Nov. 15, 1917.
- 1922 Line was abandoned July 31, 1922.
